"Father forgive them "	Third Hour (9:00 AM)	Christ is an intercessor who forgives
"Today you will be with me in Paradise"		Those who trust in Christ will be with Christ
"Behold your son behold your mother"	Sixth Hour (12:00 PM)	Jesus cares for others
"My God, my God, why have you forsaken me"		Sin separates
"I thirst"		Jesus was fully human
"It is finished"		The work of atonement is finished
"Father into your hands I commit my spirit"	Ninth Hour (3:00 PM)	Jesus does the will of his Father

2. The burial of the Lord (15:42–47)

- A centurion's confirmation of Jesus' death (15:45).
- Joseph's wrapping of Jesus' body and placing it in a tomb (15:46)
- Mary Magdalene and Mary the mother of Joses taking note of where Jesus buried
