Jesus, the King and Savior Children's Discovery Bible

The Bible tells us Jesus and His helpers were going to Jerusalem. Jesus told two of His helpers to go into a small town near the city. "You will find a donkey tied up there. Bring it to Me," said Jesus. "Someone may ask you why you are taking the donkey. Tell him the Lord needs it."

The helpers found the donkey. They said that the Lord needed it. Then they took it to Jesus. Some helpers put their coats on the donkey's back. Jesus rode the donkey to Jerusalem. As Jesus went along, people laid their coats and palm branches on the dirt road in front of Him. They did this to show Jesus that they wanted Him to be their king.

Many people began to shout, "Hosanna! Jesus is our king! He comes in the name of God!" The people waved palm branches as He passed by them. Some men in the crowd said to Jesus, "Make the people stop shouting and singing." "No," said Jesus. "Let them shout and sing their songs of praise."

A few nights later Jesus went to a garden where He liked to go to pray. His helpers went with Him, but they soon fell asleep. So Jesus prayed all alone.

Jesus said to God, "Father I know You want Me to die to save people from their sins. It will be a very hard thing. But I'll do what You want me to do. I will be the Savior."

Very soon after that, Jesus did die. The Savior died and came alive again so that we can be in God's family.
