Activities

"Follow Me"

• Invite children to play freely but explain that when you say, "Follow Me, *[child's name]*," that they must stop and follow you in a walk around the room. Repeat multiple times randomly throughout the day.

<u>Team Jesus</u>

- On a piece paper, write TEAM JESUS at the top.
- Give your child markers/crayons and have them draw things that they do to show how they follow Jesus. Examples are:
 - going to church, reading the Bible, praying, sharing toys, helping your parents, telling someone about Jesus.

Gone Fishing

Supplies needed: fish shapes, paper clips (large or small), wooden dowel or stick, string/yarn/fishing line (cut to 4 feet long), tape, magnet

- Print the fish shapes below. (you can also cut some out of construction paper)
- \circ Attach the paper somewhere on the fish (the mouth is a good place)
- Tie or tape one end of the length of yarn to a ruler, wooden dowel, tree stick, large spoon, etc to make a fishing pole.
- Tie or tape a magnet to the other end of the fishing pole. (if you do not have a magnet by itself, you can improvise and use a refrigerator magnet)
- Scatter the fish on the floor, in a bucket, etc and let your child go "fishing" using their hand made fishing rod.
