

Craft Instructions

Supplies Needed: Cardstock or heavy printer paper, string/yarn/fishing line, tape, scissors, hole punch, pen/marker/crayons

1. Print the craft pages below: fish, Jesus crown.
2. Write the names of the disciples (one per fish)
Matthew, James, Simon, Thomas, Thaddaeus, Judas, Peter,
James, Philip, Andrew, John, Bartholomew
3. Color or decorate the fish (don't make them too heavy so the craft can hang)
4. Color and decorate the Crown.
5. Cut out the fish. Cut out the Crown.
6. Cut **FOUR** strands of string/yarn/fishing line. (about 16" - 18" each) Set **ONE** strand aside.
7. Tape **THREE** strands onto the back of the Crown spacing them out about 3.5" apart. (See Sample).
8. Punch a hole in each fish. (**alternate directions down below**)
9. Using **ONE** strand, thread it through the hole of **ONE** fish and secure with a knot. (See Sample)
10. On the same strand, drop down about 2.5" - 3" and thread another fish on it. Complete this until **FOUR** fish are on the same strand.
11. Repeat steps 9 and 10 for the remaining **TWO** strands.
12. Punch holes on the Crown. (one on the upper left side and one on the upper right side)
13. Thread the reserved strand into the hole on the left side and secure with a knot.
14. Thread the other end of the strand into the right side hole and secure with a knot.
15. Hang the craft so your child can learn the names of Jesus' chosen disciples. 😊

Alternate Directions for steps 8—14

- Instead of punching holes in the fish, secure them onto each strand using tape.
- You can also use tape to secure the reserved strand onto the back of the Crown to hang it.
